

ORDINANCE NO. 4, 2012

PROHIBITING PLACING MUD OR DEBRIS UPON PUBLIC HIGHWAY

EFFECTIVE MARCH 14, 2012

SECTION 1. Construction sites and other property within the village must be maintained in a proper manner so that mud and other debris are not tracked onto public streets.

SECTION 2. If mud and debris is tracked onto the street, the contractor or property owner from which the mud and debris emanated must clean the street promptly.

SECTION 3. Debris includes unnatural accumulations of snow and ice, including that which is pushed onto the public streets from private parking lots, driveways and roads.

SECTION 4. Whoever violates the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a minor misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined as provided under the Ohio Revised Code. Any person who violates the provisions of this Ordinance a second or more time within 12 months of the previous violation shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor of the fourth degree. Each day a violation exists shall be deemed a separate offense and may be cited as such.
