


So what is a Knox Box?

- A Knox Box is a highly secure key box. The Knox Box is the answer to unneeded forced entry to a resident. The Knox Box allows the fire department to gain access to the residents without forced entry. The way the box works is, your residential key is placed in the Knox Box, which the Fire Department has a master key for. This allows access to your residents with out damage to your property.
- Knox Box is a simple, yet secure way to protect your family and property by giving you piece of mind in case of an emergency. Knox Box system is currently used nation wide for business. This allows the fire department to gain access to the business during non-business hours. By using Knox Box it allows the Miami Township fire department to better serve its residents and prevent property damage.

Fire Department Key Secure

- The fire department's master key is secured in a key secure box located in each of our first in pieces of fire equipment and life squads. Each firefighter is assigned their own unique password which is used to remove the master key from the lock box, this is recorded by the unit with dates and times the key was used. The fire department can access this information at any time.

- The residential Knox Box program is set up as a loan base program. The Knox Box is free of charge for Miami Township residents. The Knox Box will remain at the resident's home until residents move or the Knox Box is no longer needed. At that point the Knox Box will be returned to the Miami Township Fire Department, and reused at another resident.

Along with receiving a Knox Box you will be given a Vial of Life. This Vial of Life will list all of your medical history and medication, which will help EMS personnel when at your residents for an emergency.

- The goal of the residential Knox Box program is to insure that the resident that needs a Knox Boxes gets one. From the list above the Miami Township Fire Department will be able to better determine priority patients, and thus getting them a Knox Box.
